Tumor Microenvironment Jul 25 2019 The way a cell undergoes malignant transformation should meet their capacity of surviving in the microenvironment of the organ where the cancer will develop.

Metabolic adaptation is for sure one of the criteria that must be accomplished, driven by metabolic plasticity that allows the adaptation of cancer cells to the availability of energy and biomass sources that will sustain cell survival and proliferation. Biomedical Image or Genomic Data Characterization and Radiogenomic/Image-omics Jan 29 2020  
Much of the emphasis in discussions about personalized medicine has been focused on the molecular characterization of tissue samples using microarray technology. However, as genetic differ between and within tumors and are quite heterogeneous, these techniques are limited. Imaging is noninvasive and is often used in routine clinical practice for disease diagnosis, treatment, and prognosis. Radiogenomics investigates relationships between imaging features and genomics, which represents the correlation between the anatomical-histological level to the genomic level. With advanced artificial intelligence methods, especially deep learning, data processing, feature extraction and data integration have been greatly improved.
