Perceiving in Depth, Volume 1: Basic Mechanisms Mar 07 2021 The three-volume work *Perceiving in Depth* is a sequel to *Binocular Vision and Stereopsis* and to *Seeing in Depth*, both by Ian P. Howard and Brian J. Rogers. This work is much broader in scope than the previous books and includes mechanisms of depth perception by all senses, including aural, electrosensory organs, and the somatosensory system. Volume 1 reviews sensory coding, psychophysical and analytic procedures, and basic visual mechanisms. Volume 2 reviews stereoscopic vision. Volume 3 reviews all mechanisms of depth perception other than stereoscopic vision. The three volumes are extensively illustrated and referenced and provide the most detailed review of all aspects of perceiving the three-dimensional world. Volume 1 starts with a review of the history of visual science from the ancient Greeks to the early 20th century with special attention devoted to the discovery of the principles of perspective and stereoscopic vision. Volume 1 ends with accounts of the accommodation mechanism of the human eye and vergence eye movements.
