A critical and detailed discussion of the latest test with the LAGEOS satellites is included. The book will also be useful for better understanding the

interplay among various geodetic, geophysical, general relativistic, astronomical and matter-wave interferometric effects which occurs in the weak-field and slow-motion approximation and which will become increasingly important in the near future thanks to the improvements in the accuracy of the orbital reconstruction process.
