Why The Bear Has No Tail and Other Russian Fairy-Tales Nov 30 2019 Towards the end of the 19th century, the English art journalist Netta Peacock travelled to Russia where she met Elena Polenova, the artist and younger sister of the famous artist Vasily Polenov.
